Diagnoses:

- Down Syndrome- low muscle tone, low mobility in colon, very flexible, small oral cavity/ear canals, compromised immune system, atlantoaxial instability NOT PRESENT in Dec 2015 x rays
- Aspirates on thin fluids leading to frequent pneumonias
- Far sighted and stigmatism, glasses worn full time
- Low muscle tone in throat allows throat to collapse (Stridor)
- Heart is good. Eco performed Jan 2013

Communication:

- Communicates with gestures and vocal sounds but few words
- Slow processing time, give 10 seconds between questions
- Answers YES/NO questions well
- Extremely sensitive to social cues
